Waverly Transportation Policy for Co-Op Sports

- In an effort to provide all students every opportunity to be a part of extra-curricular activities, the Waverly School District is providing transportation to the Co-op sports programs. The district wants to insure all student's safety and will therefore ask parents to agree to the following procedures when using the district provided transportation for Co-op sports.
- Students will be picked up at least 20 minutes prior to the start of practice, unless prior arrangements have been made, prior to the start of a practice. Students will be picked up at a time to get them athlete to the game when the coach needs them to prepare for the game. All sports have different warm-up times and we at Waverly will do our best to meet the coach's request to allow athletes to prepare for their athletic contests.
- Athletes that ride the bus to practice are expected to ride the bus back to Waverly after practice
 concludes, unless a parent or guardian has made arrangements with building principal and
 athletic director. If an athlete does not ride the bus to practice then they will not be allowed to
 ride the bus back to Waverly after practice, unless prior arrangements have been made with the
 building principal and athletic director.
- The bus will leave promptly at the designated time and a second trip will not be provided. If the athlete misses the school provided transportation it will be the responsibility of the parent or guardian, to find a way to the activity. An athlete is not allowed to drive to an activity without approval of the building principal.
- Co-Op Games at New Berlin: Students will be transported to the game in New Berlin whether it is a home game or an away game. Students may be transported back to Waverly from games if the athlete gives the building principal notice the day before the game that transportation will be needed. If there is a Waverly employee on the coaching staff that also has their bus license, that employee will be able to transport their athletes to and from all games.
- **Co-Op Games at Franklin:** Franklin will transport students to and from a game. They will be picked up and delivered back to the Waverly School parking lot. Students may be signed out by a parent at the ball game. Waverly will transport students to a Franklin home game and will also return athletes to Waverly from home games at Franklin if notice is given to the building principal the day before the game.

All students must ride the district provided transportation unless the, *Driving Consent, Waiver, Release from Liability, and Hold Harmless Agreement,* is signed and on file in the High School office.
